## Macy's Story

This tournament is in memory of Macy Michelle Easom, daughter of Jeff and Angel Easom of Warner Robins, GA. Macy had just turned five years old when she lost her life to a rare form of liver cancer called hepatoblastoma.

Macy and Megan, identical twins, were born May 27, 2000, ten weeks before their expected birth. After six weeks in the neonatal ICU, we were finally able to bring "our girls" home. We felt blessed to finally be on the road to a healthy journey raising Megan and Macy, with the help of their proud brother Landon. Megan and Macy were normal, vivacious, energetic little girls with no apparent health problems. They filled our lives with much excitement, love and joy. As the girls celebrated their third birthday, we welcomed home another daughter, Lindsey, to our family.

We were elated to finally settle back into our home state of Georgia in August of 2004. Everything seemed great! Unfortunately this peace did not last long as Macy was diagnosed with Stage IV hepatoblastoma with lung metastasis. After multiple rounds of aggressive chemotherapy to shrink her tumor for surgical resection, we were finally able to undergo resection of the tumor, and doctors felt they were successful in complete tumor removal. We were hopeful for a complete recovery and were happy to have our little angel back. However, within four weeks, we received news that the cancer had returned to her little body. Again we tried aggressive chemotherapy with no success. Her cancer was spreading and it seemed as though we had exhausted all options.

After numerous conversations with expert physicians all over the country, and speaking with our pastor, we knew it was time to let go. We stayed by her side as she enjoyed time with her brother and sisters until she took her last breath.

We all loved her so much. There was something different about Macy - a sweetness that can't be described. We are so thankful for the time God gave us with her.
